Malakoff Radiance Signs SPPA with Senai Airport

Kuala Lumpur, 2 December 2022 – Malakoff Radiance Sdn Bhd (“Malakoff Radiance”), the solar arm of Malakoff Corporation Berhad (“Malakoff”) and Senai Airport Terminal Services Sdn Bhd (“Senai Airport”) have inked a Solar Power Purchase Agreement (“SPPA”) for the development and operation of a solar energy system at Senai Airport, Johor. The agreement was signed by Encik Anwar Syahrin Abdul Ajib, Malakoff’s Managing Director/Chief Executive Officer (“MD/CEO”), and Encik Kennedy Ayu, CEO of Senai Airport Terminal Services Sdn Bhd at a signing ceremony which was held at Senai Airport today.

Under this agreement, Malakoff Radiance will install a solar photovoltaic (“PV”) facility under the Build, Own and Operate (“BOO”) model at Senai Airport for a period of 15 years. With a generating capacity of 0.615 MWp and total electricity generation of 800 MWh per annum, the built-in solar panels are expected to contribute towards a carbon reduction of 555.2 tCO₂e per year, which is equivalent to a carbon sequestration of 14,236 trees.

Commenting on the SPPA, Encik Anwar Syahrin is optimistic about the partnership as it will further accelerate Malakoff’s Renewable Energy (“RE”) growth and serve as a catalyst in driving the green energy transformation in the country. This strategic collaboration is also a continuation of Malakoff’s efforts to be the partner-of-choice for clients who are embarking on their sustainability journey to achieve their corporate green goals.

“Strategically located in one of the country’s flagship development zones – Iskandar Malaysia, Senai Airport ranks as one of the busiest and fastest growing airports in Malaysia while serving as an aviation gateway to the Southern region. With a multitude of traffic and growing energy consumption, the installation and operation of solar PV will further boost Senai Airport’s transition to green energy, thus saving electricity consumption and lowering carbon emissions. This sustainability-driven action plan serves as a testament to Malakoff’s commitment towards continuously delivering dependable, green energy to our communities as we aim to ultimately achieve the Nation’s target in becoming a carbon-neutral country by 2050,” he said.

Speaking on behalf of Senai Airport, Encik Kennedy Ayu said, “In line with the Group’s Environment, Sustainability and Governance (ESG) initiatives, Senai Airport is embarking towards becoming a green airport by integrating sustainability into its airport planning. Indisputably, climate change is one of the greatest challenges globally and we recognise that the aviation industry has a significant role to play in reducing its carbon impact on the environment.”

“In the interest of air safety and to conscientiously not disrupt the air traffic control sight, a detailed glare analysis has identified two rooftop locations – the terminal building and open carpark. Additionally, we hope that this initiative will foster other energy-saving efforts amongst our stakeholders in the future,” he added.

Through this SPPA, Malakoff and Senai Airport continue to spearhead their sustainability agenda through comprehensive, best-in-class operations and strong commitment to sustainability and innovation as they accelerate growth and embark on a common objective of reducing carbon footprints.

Built in 1974, the airport was operated by Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad until November 2003 and subsequently acquired by Senai Airport Terminal Services which was later acquired by MMC Corporation Berhad in 2009.</p> <p>Senai International Airport serves as the aviation gateway for Iskandar Malaysia and the southern region and is dedicated to providing routes and services essential to cater to the needs of both tourism and business travellers. Equipped with a 3,800-metre runway, Senai International Airport can handle aircrafts ranging from small Cessnas to large jets such as Airbus A380 and Antonov 125. Currently, there are 5 airlines operating in Senai International Airport serving 12 domestic and six international destinations with an average of 110 flight movements and 11,500 passengers daily.</p> <p>In 2018, Senai International Airport was named ‘Asia Pacific Regional Airport of the Year 2018’ under the category of less than 10 million annual passengers at the CAPA Asia Pacific Aviation Awards for Excellence 2018 for its leading role in using new biometrics technology and its support of the Low-Cost Carrier (LCC) model, which has driven rapid growth.</p> <p>In January 2019, SATSSB entered into a contract with Sanzbury Stead Sdn Bhd (Sanzbury Stead), a subsidiary of Petroliam Nasional Berhad (Petronas), to manage the operations and maintenance services of Kertih Airport for three years.</p>
