Towards the end of the year, we organised our first ‘Amazing Hunt 2023’, a treasure hunt involving staff, stakeholders, media and Key Opinion Leaders (“KOLs”), to create awareness and provide educational exposure on recycling by gathering and weighing recyclable items at Alam Flora’s Fasiliti Inovasi Kitar Semula (“FIKS”) facility in Putrajaya.”

“Similarly, at Alam Flora, we maintained our commitment to promoting recycling and proper waste management through several initiatives. We educated over 11,000 visitors through visits to our FIKS since its 2020 opening. Additionally, our events like the ‘Sustainability Hunt’ and

'Cyber Eco Hunt 2023', much like the 'Amazing Hunt 2023', engaged the community, raised environmental awareness, and included outreach to social media influencers and KOLs In Kuantan, our 'Karnival Saya Sayang Bumi' drew over 2,000 attendees to reinforce environmental responsibilities. Furthermore, our 'Waste is Amazing' fashion show, involving 100 designers, creatively promoted the 3R concept through innovative designs", added Anwar Syahrin.
