## **MALAKOFF SECURED COMMUNITY-FOCUSED SOLAR PROJECT WITH MASJID SAIDINA UMAR AL-KHATTAB**

**KUALA LUMPUR, Malaysia – 10 April 2025:** Malakoff Radiance Sdn Bhd (“MRSB”), the commercial and industrial solar subsidiary of Malakoff Corporation Berhad (“Malakoff”), has entered into a Solar Power Purchase Agreement (“SPPA”) with Masjid Saidina Umar Al-Khattab (“MSUA”) in Bukit Damansara, Kuala Lumpur for the development of a 203 kWp Building-Integrated Photovoltaic (“BIPV”) Carport Solar system. The agreement was signed by Tan Sri Che Khalib Mohamad Noh, Chairman of Malakoff and Tan Sri Syed Hamid bin Syed Jaafar Albar, Chairman of the Management Committee from MSUA.

As the Registered Solar PV Investor (“RPVI”) for this project, MRSB collaborates with MSUA, the client, to deliver sustainable energy solutions. This initiative will reduce electricity costs for MSUA, promoting cost savings through clean energy adoption. This marks MRSB’s inaugural venture into community-based solar project installations, paving the way for similar projects in the future.

The solar project was completed within a four-month timeline under a Zero CAPEX scheme. Notably, the project features a 100% BIPV carport design. The solar panels serve as a dual-purpose structure, functioning as both the roof of the carport and a green energy generator. This provides shaded parking for over 40 vehicles, combining sustainability with practical community benefits.

Commenting on this milestone, Malakoff’s Managing Director and Group Chief Executive Officer (“MD & GCEO”), Anwar Syahrin Abdul Ajib, expressed his enthusiasm for the company’s foray into community-focused Renewable Energy (“RE”) initiatives. He emphasised that this project aligns seamlessly with Malakoff’s overarching purpose of enhancing lives and enriching the communities it serves.

“This collaboration with MSUA marks yet another significant milestone in our journey toward fostering community sustainable development. By making a positive impact on the surrounding community, this green initiative exemplifies the transformative potential of RE. We hope it inspires other organisations and entities to embrace similar sustainability efforts for a brighter and more sustainable future. Through this project, we aim to raise awareness and share knowledge about the long-term benefits of RE implementation, particularly solar energy.
